

## Birds of Lincoln Park, West Seattle (confirmed)

S = Shoreline and Salish Sea (Puget Sound), common; s = less common; s-1 = one sighting only

F = Forests and meadows, common; f = less common; f-1 = one sighting only

N = Spotted in neighborhoods around Lincoln Park but rarely in park; n = less common; n-1 = one sighting only

\* = Confirmed nesting in park through personal observation. \*sh = nests in shrubs; \*t = nests in trees. **Note that many additional species (including warblers, flycatchers, and others) can be presumed to nest in the park as well.**
